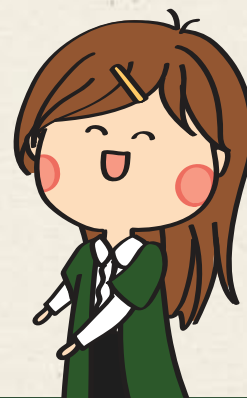
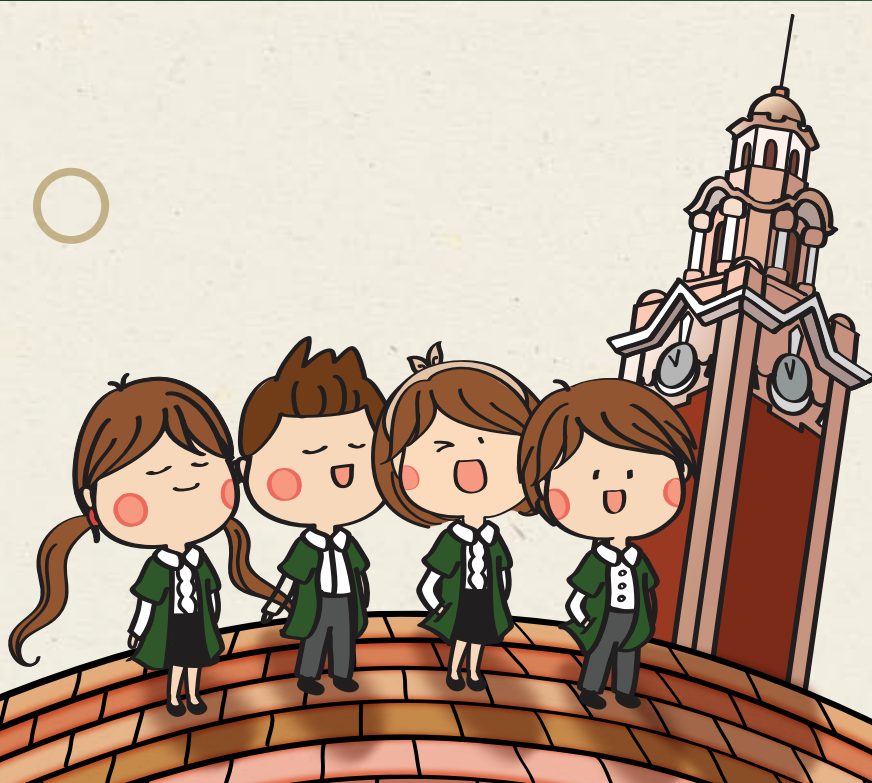

# Registration Instructions



By registering to visit the campus of  
The University of Hong Kong (HKU), you agree to the following:

1

The University of Hong Kong (HKU) is a prestigious educational and research institution with ongoing academic activities. Visitors are required to observe the Rules and Regulations for Tourists.

Individuals can make an online reservation to visit the campus up to 14 days in advance. "Visit HKU" is the official platform for individuals to reserve a visit to the HKU campus, which can be accessed after completing a successful real-name registration.

Please select one of the available timeslots for registration. Each individual can only successfully register once every 14 days.

4

Each person can register for up to three additional accompanying guests. The registrant and their accompanying guests must enter the University together. Children under eight years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian during the visit.

No registration is needed for public holidays in Hong Kong, Sundays, or weekdays before 8:00 am or after 6:30 pm. Campus visits may be suspended during University adjustments, significant events, or extreme weather conditions.

After successful registration, please enter through the designated access points with your valid ID documents. Log in to the registration system to obtain the QR code during the reserved timeslot and undergo verification.

Visitors arriving at HKU outside the reserved timeslot will be considered to have automatically cancelled their registration. If you cannot attend, please cancel your registration in the system before midnight on the day of the visit. Failure to show up without reason will result in a 14-day restriction on future registrations. If the University is temporarily closed due to adjustments, significant events, or extreme weather, the reserved quota for the day will automatically become invalid.

The campus has non-public areas, including student dormitories, teaching and research facilities, sports centres, and administrative offices. Please do not enter any non-public areas without permission.

Please comply with the relevant laws and regulations of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government, campus management rules, and follow the instructions and guidance of University staff. Abide by social norms, protect the campus environment, vegetation, and cultural relics, and do not disturb the normal teaching, research, and campus activities of the University.
